began in the summer of 2018. The National office was directly involved in this development even though they had no idea what would happen when they sent \$15,000 to CPD SDMI to use as we saw fit. The determination was to use the funds to launch a specific and targeted leadership development program for the summer of 2018. We hired 2 adult leaders part-time and upwards of 15 youth were actively engaged in ministry throughout the entire summer because of this program.

The dream and hope of the team was to continue training and equipping for ministry on an ongoing basis following the summer. This has happened on a very limited scale but the potential for sustained engagement of young leaders in our local churches under the tutelage of the iLEAD program is unlimited. The single most significant barrier to developing this potential is funding. We have committed, willing, capable youth who are anxious to serve and to learn how to lead. We have adult leaders who are willing and ready to teach and to help open doors for our youth unleashing their leadership influence and impact for the Kingdom.

POTENTIAL STREAMS FOR 2019

Those engaged in a specific stream will also participate in basic training that sets foundational principles and essential practices in place for all participants.

1. **Unleashing Vision & Implementation Skills:**

- "What and Why" Teaching and hands-on experience regarding how to determine purpose in decision-making that relates to ministry development and initiatives. The group will also learn how to implement shared vision. Projects that develop leaders and support local churches will come out of these teams.
- Continuing work to assist local churches with VBS outreach in 2019.

3. **Compassionate Ministries Awareness & Engagement**

- Intro level – onsite visits i. e. Mission Possible and/or Victoria Warehouse and other compassionate ministries.
- Tools for ongoing participation in Freedom Sunday supporting NCM work in Moldova.

2. **Pastoral / Leadership Discernment Stream:**

- Pastoral & Christian Ministries – exposure to real ministry/shadowing of pastors/round table conversations with pastors/leaders about following God's call to ministry.
- Training we will call, "The Onion" -- an inner look at the church through the lens of being a leader. Training centered around how to act and behave as a leader so you BUILD relationships and serve well.
- Exposure – Intro level development and increased understanding of our church, its theology, its ministries, function, government & scope globally.
